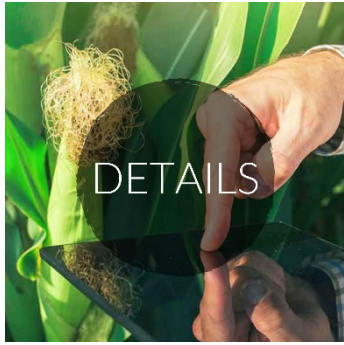

Objective

The objective of this school is to provide loss adjusters with corn and soybean crop hail instruction and field training. The field exercises provided at the test plots will incorporate adjusting hail damage in several different stages of development for both corn and soybeans. This school is intended to benefit adjusters who have little or no adjusting experience to adjusters who have medium or intermediate crop hail adjusting experience.

Material Needed

IL/WI NCIS Committee will provide Corn, Soybean and Wheat crop hail adjusting manuals, slide cards and survey sheets.

Attendees need to bring a tape measure, a clipboard, and a knife to split corn stalks.
