## Objective

The objective of this school is to provide loss adjusters with corn and soybean crop hail instruction and field training. The field exercises provided at the test plots will incorporate adjusting hail damage in several different stages of development for both corn and soybean. This school is intended to benefit adjusters who have little or no adjusting experience to adjusters who have medium or intermediate crop hail adjusting experience.

## Material Needed
